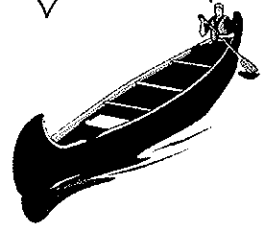

## FREE FUND RAISING FOR CHHA

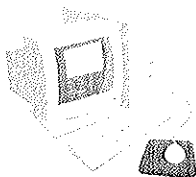
Free money for Cliff Haven!

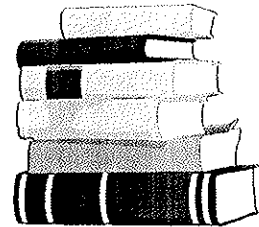
